On May 24, 2015 North Park Christian Fellowship with the direction of the Holy Spirit and support from Horizon Christian Fellowship changed its name and vision. Horizon North Park Christian Fellowship with its new vision of today, "Tell, Teach, Train" are committed to fulfilling the Great Commission according to: Matthew 28:18-20
