The History of Horizon North Park Christian Fellowship

Horizon North Park Christian Fellowship started from a home fellowship of about 50 believers through Horizon Christian Fellowship, under the name of North Park Christian Fellowship. In 1984, Horizon Christian Fellowship was called out of the North Park community, so the Lord raised up 12 of the 50 believers who felt the Lord leading them to continue the fellowship in the North Park area. In November of 1986, with the approval of the Pastors and Elders of Horizon Christian Fellowship, North Park Christian Fellowship was born with the vision of "To Glorify God and to Serve People".

On May 24, 2015 North Park Christian Fellowship with the direction of the Holy Spirit and support from Horizon Christian Fellowship changed its name and vision. Horizon North Park Christian Fellowship with its new vision of today, "Tell, Teach, Train" are committed to fulfilling the Great Commission according to:
