Ushers use their gift of hospitality in greeting newcomers and regulars in the sanctuary. They also assist with seating, offering, distributing Bibles and communion. They often arrive early to ensure the sanctuary is prepared and stay late picking up bulletins and other items left behind. Ushers also direct people to the appropriate person and/or places.

Statement of Faith

Horizon North Park Christian Fellowship has been formed as a fellowship of believers in the *Lordship of Jesus Christ*. Our supreme desire is to know *Christ* and be *conformed* into His image by the *power of the Holy Spirit*.

We are not a denominational church, nor are we opposed to demoninations as such, only their over emphasis of doctrinal differences that have led to the division of the *Body of Christ*.

We believe that the only true basis of Christian Fellowship is *His* (*Agape*) *love*, which is greater than any differences we possess and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.

We believe the *Worship of God* should be *Spiritual*. Therefore, we remain flexible and yielded to the *Holy Spirit* to direct our *Worship*.

We believe the *Worship of God* should be *Inspirational*. Therefore, we give a great place to music in our *Worship*.

We believe the *Worship of God* should be *Intelligent*. Therefore, our services are designed with great emphasis upon *Teaching of the Word of God* that *He* might instruct us how He should be *worshipped*.

We believe the *Worship of God* is *Fruitful*. Therefore, we look for *His love* in our lives as the supreme manifestation that we have truly been *Worshipping Him*.

We believe the *Worship of God* as the Creator of all things. We believe that God created man and that he created them male and female. As such He created them different so as to compliment and to complete each other. God instituted marriage between male and female as the foundation of the family, the basic structure of human society. For this reason homosexuality, and all other "sexual preferences" or "orientation" are unnatural, sinful, and unacceptable to God (1 Corinthians 6:9-11; 1 Timothy 1:9-11). Accordingly, this ministry will not perform any marriage ceremonies between individuals of the same biological sex. It will not condone or recognize such same-sex marriages, civil unions or such unions or domestic partnership, even if the states establishes laws that provide for recognition of such unions (Genesis 2:21-24; Romans 1:26-32; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 13:20, 11:1-16, 14:35; Ephesians 5:22-33; 1 Timothy 2:9-15).

We believe that marriage is exclusively the union of one genetic male and one genetic female and evidenced by a marriage ceremony. We also believe that legitimate biblical sexual relations are exercised soley within marriage. Hence, sexual and behavioral activites such as, but not limited to, adultery, fornication, premartial sex, incest, polygamy, homosexuality, transgenderism, bisexuality, cross dressing, pedophilia, and bestiality are inconsistent with the teaching of the Bible and the Church. Further, lascivious behavior, the creation of, viewing and/or distribution of pornography, and efforts to alter one's physical gender or gender related appearance are incompatible with a true Biblical witness (Genesis 2:24; 1 Corinthians 5:11, 6:9, 6:18-20, 7:1-3, 7:8-9; Romans 1:18-32).

We believe marriage to be an institution ordained by God at the creation of man (Genesis 3). We believe that Scripture clearly teaches that God is opposed to divorce and that hardness of heart is the root cause of all divorce (Matthew 19:8-10). We believe that married couples are to pursue reconciliation (Matthew 18), and are not to seek to be divorce (1 Corinthians 7). We do understand that divorce may be outside the control of one or the other person in a marriage. Biblical grounds for divorce are defined as "an unbeliever departing" (1 Corinthians 7), and "adultery" (Matthew 19). Any divorce outside these Biblical exceptions is believed to be unbiblical.
